#### **RUBBISH! RUBBISH! SATURDAY 22 JUNE**

The bin lorry will be positioned according to the following approximate times. Please note – **the times are only approximate** – if all goes quiet at one stop, we'll move on to the next, so the earlier you bring out your rubbish the better.

9.00 – 9.45 am Opposite 59 Canning Road

9.45 – 10.30 am Outside the Edward Jobson Court, Canning Road (near the church)

10.30 - 11.15 am Outside 102 Clyde Road

11.15 am – 12.00 noon Outside 39 Clyde Road (lorry may leave early if things go guiet)

There are some restrictions. Items not allowed are: **X** Fridges/freezers/white goods. **X** Building rubble, **X** Car tyres, **X** Aerosols, pressurised containers, **X** Liquids

Please prepare your rubbish beforehand. It is your responsibility to bring it to the lorry. If you have heavy items, let us know in advance and we will see if we can help you carry it.

Fridges can be taken away separately for free by the Council. Other white goods will also be removed for a small charge, typically £10 - £15. Just phone the Council on 020 8255 2708 or 020 8255 2700 to arrange this.
